

Note:

1. The *Emergency Services Telecommunicator* position requires successful completion of designated courses with certifications (generally within six months of starting employment) and maintaining continuing education requirements after employment.
2. The 911 center operates 24/7 daily including all Holidays, Disasters and other declared or mandated emergencies.
3. The 911 Center is responsible for receiving emergency calls for assistance from the general public and dispatching of appropriate first responders and Public Safety Agencies for Perry County Ohio.
4. Mandatory Overtime and call-ins are conditional to employment concerning this position.
5. Employees must have the ability to communicate effectively handling stressful situations and take appropriate action.
6. Position is hourly with overtime paid in excess of 40 hours.
7. Overtime may be mandated due to coverage/staffing requirements.
8. APCO Telecommunicator and EMD certification preferred.
