Ohio University Heritage College of Osteopathic Medicine (OU-HCOM) Community Health Programs (CHP) develops and delivers quality health care services for children and adults throughout southeastern Ohio through a stationary and mobile clinic. Our services were initiated in response to unmet health care needs and are often geared toward clients and patients who lack adequate medical alternatives. As part of our services we offer free breast and cervical cancer screenings for uninsured, insured and under-insured women.
