Position Summary

The Mobility Manager position will develop and implement a Transportation Services plan that incorporates local Human Services entities and coordinates programs for the purpose of improving overall transportation services for our underserved low income, disabled and elderly populations. The position requires collaboration with transportation, social services and other area agencies to ensure the most effective, efficient and productive strategy is established.

This position is Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funded and contingent upon continued and future grant funding. Position scope must meet all program requirements as specified in the FTA program.

Duties

- Develop and maintain the Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Plan for Perry County
- Research, identify develop, and submit grant applications to secure future funding
- Identify transportation needs of low income, disabled and aged populations
- Identify and implement strategies for meeting transportation needs
- Cultivate community support and recognition of available transportation
- Coordinate and assist in elimination of trip duplication by Perry County Agencies
- Develop a system of outreach to low-income, socially isolated older and/or disabled adults and assist them in gaining access to needed transportation services
- Remove barriers for transportation for employment, medical appointments and employment support services for individuals with disabilities in rural areas
- Attend conferences, meetings, and trainings as required as assigned and appropriate to the position
- Analysis, track and report data
- Identify gaps in services and work with partners to execute resolutions
- Establish and cultivate relationships with Perry County partners
- Ability to coordinate multiple projects simultaneously
- Excellent communication skills to included public speaking.

Qualifications

A Bachelor's Degree in Transportation Planning, Public Administration, Community Planning, or other related field preferred. Prior job experience in public sector transportation, is preferred. Associates degree with relevant experience may be considered.
