One of the greatest opportunities we have to work the democratic process is to serve as a poll worker on Election Day. The Perry County Board of Elections is reaching out to find our friends in the corporate community to find enthusiastic, detail-oriented associates who are active in their community.

Through our new Champions of Democracy program, we will recruit and train poll workers from businesses like yours. Some organizations may provide paid leave while others will require employees to take vacation or other leave time to participate.

There is not a cost associated with participating and each poll worker receives compensation from the Perry County Board of Elections (at least \$105.25 for Election Day services and \$8.55 per hour for training). **To show our appreciation, every Champion of Democracy participant will be recognized on our social media platforms and in a Perry County Tribune article following the election.**

Other counties in Ohio are running successful programs like ours and have been very successful in recruiting hundreds of poll workers from Huntington Bank, AEP, Nationwide and The Ohio State University.

Here's how the program works:

- Your business provides poll workers to serve on Election Day
- Your workers attend training and work their entire shift on Election Day
- Your employees may wear shirts with your business logo to promote your business while working the polls (non-political apparel)
- The Board of Elections staff will be available to assist you throughout the entire process

In order to serve on Election Day, each employee must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen and a registered Perry County voter
- Have transportation to the polls
- Work from 5:30 a.m. to at least 8:00 p.m. on Election Day
