## Vector Control Intern Opportunity

The Perry County Health Department has an exciting opportunity for a paid part-time summer internship in the Mosquito Surveillance and Control Program.

The internship will begin in mid-April of this year and continue through September. The intern will work 20 hours per week, with 2 to 4 days being between the hours of 7pm-12am and 5 to 7 hours per week during regular Health Department business hours. The rate of pay is \$9.00 per hour.

Under the supervision of a Sanitarian, the intern will have the ability to learn about the biology of a mosquito and mosquito borne illnesses. Also, the intern will learn about proper pesticide application techniques, handling, laws, and safety. The intern will learn how to operate mosquito pesticide application equipment and how to trap mosquitos.

Applicants must be 18 or older and have a valid Ohio driver's license with an acceptable driving record. Both high school and college students are encouraged to apply.
