Under direction, oversees activities of Nurse Aides on assigned shift; performs general nursing care; monitors, reports to supervisor, and records health condition of residents; performs other related duties as required.

Qualifications: Any combination of training and work experience which indicates possession of the skills, knowledge and abilities listed below; completion of state accredited school of licensed practical nursing and completion of state approved pharmacology program; licensed to practice practical nursing in State of Ohio.

Duties:

- Assigns and monitors activities of Nurse Aides on assigned shifts according to quality standards, facility policy and governmental regulations.
- Makes rounds to monitor health conditions of residents, records and reports changes in condition of residents. Notify physicians and responsible party of changes in residents' conditions.
- Passes medications, performs treatments as directed, checks temperature, pulse, respirations, blood pressure, weights, FSBS, oxygen therapy, order medications and supplies as needed, and other related nursing care functions.
- Receives and gives shift reports, prepares and maintains various records and reports, attends meetings, assist in feeding, bathing and other personal care activities of residents when needed
- Charting and maintaining communication with physicians and residents responsible party.
- Performs any other related duties described by the Administration.

Other Requirements: Must have a current drivers license and good driving record, providing own transportation and vehicle liability insurance; expected to work as scheduled.

If there is a change regarding your vehicle insurance and/or driving status it is your responsibility to notify management.
